

Dispatcher Training

Instructor-Led Training

Dispatcher training helps electric distribution system operators and dispatchers better understand electric power system fundamentals, field operations, common service technical issues, and personnel safety. This course includes discussions on:

- Three-phase power (WYE, Delta, power factor, etc.)
- Substation equipment (transformers, regulators, breakers, etc.)
- Design concepts (feeders, laterals, bus transfer schemes, ground grids, etc.)
- Distribution lines (radial feed, loop, paralleling, underground, overhead, etc.)
- Distribution automation systems (outage management, graphical information, customer information, asset management, and advanced metering infrastructure)

Other relevant topics include protective relaying, fuse coordination, lightning, stray voltages/currents, and switching procedures. Understanding these system parameters is essential for electric distribution system operators to effectively understand field work practices and safety.

As a result of this training, dispatchers should improve corporate safety and risk management, identify with industry best practices, and minimize switching consequences under planned and unplanned (emergency) conditions.

- Explain the equipment and basic operations of electric power systems
- Describe the various types of power plants and how distributed generation applies
- Describe distribution facility's design, construction, and operational requirements
- Describe the various system protection devices used in distribution systems
- Discuss safety issues, proper procedures, and personal protection equipment
- Discuss switching, tagging, and work clearances
- Discuss distribution system operations during normal and emergency conditions
